Role Description:

The role requires travel to different regions in Gujarat to gather insights from students, staff and other relevant stakeholders.

All the interns will be provided with a pre-field training along with questionnaires and processes for data collection and documentation.

All the interns will be accompanied on field by team members from Labhya.

What's involved.

- Minimum 2-weeks travel to different regions of Gujarat (travel and accommodation will be covered)
- Responsibilities:
 - 1. Undergoing trainings
 - 2. Collecting data by facilitating discussions & 1:1 conversations with children and staff
 - 3. Taking thorough verbatim notes
 - 4. Data recording: organising and collating the data
 - 5. Translating the collected data into English/Hindi.
 - 6. Time Commitment: 8 hours/day

- Open to travel across Gujarat in January 2025
- Excellent written and oral communication skills in Gujarati & English / Hindi
