- Oversee the analysis and create visualisations of qualitative and quantitative data to support decision-making for programs.
- Lead the preparation of monitoring and evaluation reports to disseminate findings and learnings.
- Contribute to the evolution of MEL strategy and frameworks to ensure alignment with organizational goals.
- Conduct extensive research and review on existing literature and best practices related to SEL and Education, to inform program design and implementation.
- Coach a young team of associates. Mentor a young and dynamic field team to drive impact at scale.
