- Analyse field data, identify patterns or implementation bottlenecks, and provide actionable insights to the State Lead.
- Directly supervise, coach and mentor Operations Associates and Field Officers across districts.
- Identify capacity gaps in the team and design learning opportunities or recommend interventions.
- Strengthen and maintain relationships with senior district-level government officials and key stakeholders.
- Troubleshoot escalated issues from field teams, ensuring proactive resolution and consistent engagement with state/district/block officials.
- Lead or co-lead training sessions for teachers, officials, and internal team members.
- Provide strategic input into the design and delivery of training modules, toolkits, and workshops based on ground insights and feedback.
- Liaise with Labhya's curriculum, training, communications, and founders' office teams to ensure the field perspective is well integrated.
- Support documentation of impact stories, case studies, and reports for internal and external audiences.
- Represent Labhya in high-level district/state meetings when delegated by the State Lead.
- Coordinate and lead planning for partner visits, reviews, and presentations involving external stakeholders.
- Drive continuous improvement by identifying and piloting innovations in operational systems or field processes.
- Provide input to the State Lead on strategy formulation, risk mitigation, and long-term sustainability planning.
